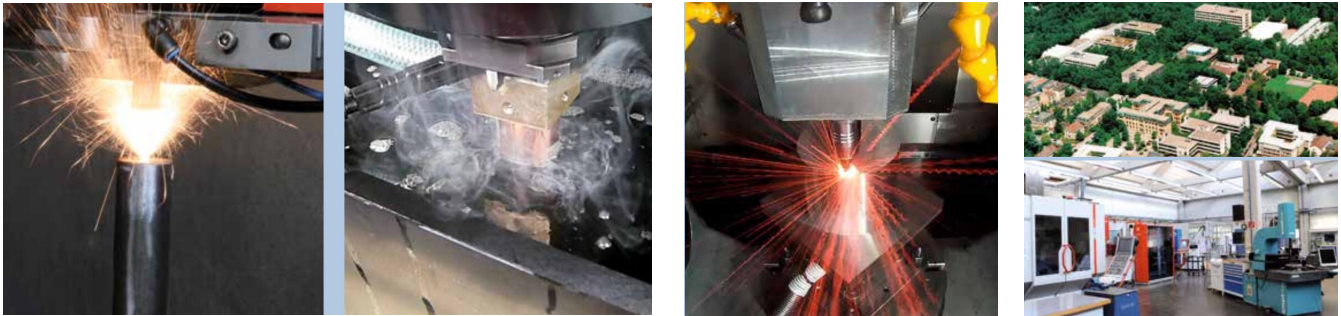




Hochschule Karlsruhe – Institute of Materials and Processes (IMP)
